Clinical Play Observation

Do you need a Clinical Play Observation completed?

It can be used to form part of a multiagency assessment or just to give an insight into the child and caregivers relationship.

Play is the language for children, and the observation will observe the themes of play, the child's play, use of caregivers, child's strength, initiation of play, concentration, movement, energy, child presentation, verbalisation, engagement with others and adult role.

Process:

- » Clinical Play Observation session
- » Summary report and recommendations
